Dalán (dah-LAHN)



- The common unit of currency. It is a small, hexagonal sapphire-like crystal whose Earth equivalent would be about \$5. They are often carved with various symbols and representations of royalty from their nation of origin but are usually accepted in any nation. The color of a crystal coin also indicates where it came from, as sapphires are formed in a variety of hues and most nations create their coins from a specific quality and color of crystal.
